

FIVE JAMAICAN CONFERENCES TO HOLD REGULAR QUADRENNIAL SESSION

The North, Central, East, West and North-east Jamaica Conferences will hold their regular Quadrennial Session during 2018.

President of the Jamaica Union Conference of Seventh-day Adventists, Pastor Everett Brown is scheduled to officiate at these sessions and chair the nominating and organizing committees.

On February 21-22, 2018, the **North Jamaica Conference** will hold its Third Quadrennial Session at its Camp Site in Duncans, Trelawny. The opening ceremony and first business session will commence on Wednesday, February 14 at 10:00 am.

The **Central Jamaica Conference** Fifth Quadrennial Session will be convened June 13--14, 2018 at Camp Verley, Spring Gardens, St. Catherine. The first business session will begin on Wednesday, June 14, 2018.

The Kencot Seventh-day Adventist Church, 10-12 Osbourne Road, Kingston 5, will be the venue for the Fifth Quadrennial Session of the **East Jamaica Conference**. It commences on Monday, June 18, 2018 with an opening ceremony at 6:30 p.m., and closes on June 19 in the afternoon.

On June 20-21, 2018, the **West Jamaica Conference** will hold its Fifth Quadrennial Session at the Seventh-day Adventist Conference Centre, Mt. Salem, St. James. The opening ceremony will commence at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday June 20, 2018.

The **North East Jamaica Conference** will host its Third Quadrennial Session on August 27-28, 2018 at Camp Don, Robins Bay, St. Mary. The Session will open on Monday, August 27 in the morning, and closes on August 28.

The sessions are called to:

1. Receive reports from the officers and the various departments.
2. Elect administrators and departmental directors to serve for the ensuing term.
3. Consider revisions and changes to the Conferences' by-laws.
4. Discuss and appropriately adopt the strategic plan to guide the activities of the Conferences.
5. Transact such other business as may be placed before the delegates.
