The Union Conference Session is called to:

1. Receive reports from the officers and various departments.
2. Elect administrators and departmental directors to serve for the remainder of the Quinquennium ending December 2025.
3. Consider revisions and changes in the Union Conference's Constitution and By-laws.
4. Transact such other business as may be properly placed before the delegates.

All duly appointed delegates are invited to be present at this Union Conference Session.

Delegates are selected by the Conferences and Institutions of the Union, according to the terms of the Constitution and By-laws of the Jamaica Union Conference of Seventh-day Adventists.
